Immich-Batterieberg "CAI" Riesling Kabinett Mosel, Germany 2020 \$39

A light and vivid dry Mosel with plenty of yellow apple, lemon and fresh-herb aromas. Emphatically dry but polished finish

Donnhoff "Tonschiefer" Riesling Nahe, Germany 2021 \$42

Round on the palate, with fleshy stone fruit, white flowers, and a fresh salinity.

Felseneck "Prinzsalm" Riesling Kabinett Nahe, Germany 2020 \$55

Intense tropical fruit notes of grapefruit and citrus, while fresh and lively on the palate.

Powerful and rich on the nose, it is concentrated and smooth leaving room for hay, tobacco and spices. On the palate, black fruits are layered with mineral graphite notes

Mauro Molino *Barbera* d'Asti "Leradici" Piedmonte, Italy 2020 \$51

Bold cherry fruit with subtle hints of earth and dark spice. That tonic, crisp acidity that Barbera is known for shows nicely in this expression from Asti.

Tenuta Migliavacca *Grignolino del Monferrato Casalese*, Italy 2020 \$48

Dry on the palate with aromas of pink peppercorns, red currants, and lithe tannins.

Bruno Verdi "Buttafuoco" *Oltrepo Pavese*, Italy 2020 \$42

Aromas of raspberries and tart cherry are balanced by an underlying earth tone, with a well-structured, mineral-driven palate

Proprieta Sperino "Uvaggio" Piedmont, Italy 2018 \$57

80% Nebbiolo, 15% Vespolina and 5% Croatina. Red-fruited nose is subtle and understated, medium-bodied, considerable intensity, with flavours of redcurrants, mint and exotic spice.
